MSCI EAFE Value Index (net div) - a market capitalization-weighted index that is designed to measure equity market performance for value securities in the developed markets, excluding the U.S. and Canada.

Composite Dispersion is measured by the asset-weighted standard deviation of gross of fees account returns for all accounts in the composite for the full period. For composites containing less than six accounts for the full period, dispersion is deemed not meaningful and is not presented. The three-year annualized ex post standard deviation measures the variability of the gross of fees composite returns and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period.

Certain accounts in this composite may make tactical allocation to U.S. and Canadian based securities, where each investment is deemed to be consistent with the composite's overall investment objective.

Custom Benchmark Methodology: Prior to 1-Oct-2020 the benchmark was MSCI EAFE Value Index (net div) and on 1-Oct-2020 the benchmark is linked to MSCI EAFE Index (net div).

The MFS International Intrinsic Value Equity Composite is a U.S. Dollar based composite available globally. The regional composite depicted here was created on 28-Jun-2011 for presentation in the Canadian market. Where appropriate, data has been converted to Canadian Dollar and the fees and breakpoints depicted are applicable to clients in this market.
