Composite Description: The MFS International Small-Mid Cap Equity Composite includes all discretionary portfolios managed to the MFS International Small-Mid Cap Equity strategy. The strategy seeks capital appreciation by investing primarily in a diversified portfolio of equities of small-to-medium-capitalization companies whose primary activities lie outside the United States. Investments in certain markets can involve greater risk and volatility because of adverse market, currency, economic, industry, political, regulatory, geopolitical, or other conditions. Custom Benchmark: MSCI AC World (ex-US) Small Mid Cap Index (net div) - is a free float weighted index that is designed to measure equity market performance of small and mid cap companies across global developed and emerging market countries, excluding the United States. S&P Global ex U.S. SmallCap - represents the small capitalization stock component (the bottom 20% of the available market capitalization within each country) of the S&P Global Broad Market Index (BMI). The BMI is a float-weighted index that spans 22 countries and includes the listed shares of all companies with an available market capitalization (float) of at least \$100 million.

Custom Benchmark Methodology: Prior to 1-Dec-2011 the benchmark was S&P Global ex U.S. SmallCap Index and on 1-Dec-2011 the benchmark is linked to MSCI AC World (ex-US) Small Mid Cap Index (net div).

Composite Dispersion is measured by the asset-weighted standard deviation of gross of fees account returns for all accounts in the composite for the full period. For composites containing less than six accounts for the full period, dispersion is deemed not meaningful and is not presented. The three-year annualized ex post standard deviation measures the variability of the gross of fees composite returns and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period.

The MFS International Small-Mid Cap Equity Composite is a US Dollar based composite available globally. The regional composite depicted here was created on 27-Jun-2011 for presentation in the Canadian market. Where appropriate, data has been converted to Canadian Dollar and the fees and breakpoints depicted are applicable to clients in this market.

The composite asset minimum changed from 2MM USD to 1MM USD effective 1-Nov-2022.
