Composite Description: The MFS U.S. Taxable Municipal Fixed Income Composite includes all discretionary portfolios managed to the MFS U.S. Taxable Municipal Fixed Income strategy. The strategy seeks total return with an emphasis on current income. but also capital appreciation, by investing primarily in investment grade U.S. taxable and tax-exempt municipal securities. Investments in municipal instruments can be volatile and significantly affected by adverse tax or court rulings, legislative or political changes, market and economic conditions, issuer. industry-specific (including the credit quality of municipal insurers), and other conditions. Because many municipal instruments are issued to finance similar projects, conditions in certain industries can significantly affect the portfolio and the overall municipal market.

Accounts are eligible for inclusion in the composite if they have assets greater than 20 MM USD (3143.2 MM JPY). Accounts are included as of their second full month of performance.

Derivative Exposure Disclosure

Certain accounts in this composite utilize derivatives for hedging, investment exposure, implementation efficiency, and transaction cost mitigation purposes. Derivative exposures can be volatile, used to take long or short positions, involve leverage (which can magnify gains or losses), and involve counterparty and liquidity risk. The table below displays the high, median, and low month-end derivative exposures over the last three years, when available or since inception if the composite is less than three years old. Derivative exposure of the account is calculated as the gross equivalent exposure of total net assets. The derivative exposures, displayed below, are the average exposures of total net assets. Custom Benchmark Methodology: The custom benchmark blend consists of 25% Bloomberg Municipal Bond Index and 75% Bloomberg Municipal Bond - Taxable. Rebalanced monthly.

Composite Dispersion is measured by the asset-weighted standard deviation of gross of fees account returns for all accounts in the composite for the full period. For composites containing less than six accounts for the full period, dispersion is deemed not meaningful and is not presented. The three-year annualized ex post standard deviation measures the variability of the gross of fees composite returns and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period.

Prior to 1-Sep-2021 the minimum asset level for inclusion was 5.0MM USD.

The MFS U.S. Taxable Municipal Fixed Income Composite is a U.S. Dollar based composite available globally. The regional composite depicted here was created on 17-Sep-2021 for presentation in the Japanese market. Where appropriate, data has been converted to Japanese Yen and the fees and breakpoints depicted are applicable to clients in this market.
