Composite Dispersion is measured by the asset-weighted standard deviation of gross of fees account returns for all accounts in the composite for the full period. For composites containing less than six accounts for the full period, dispersion is deemed not meaningful and is not presented. The three-year annualized ex post standard deviation measures the variability of the gross of fees composite returns and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36month period.

Prior to 1-Feb-2018, the maximum institutional separate account fee charged for this product was 75 bps. From 1-Feb-2018 through 31-Aug-2020, the maximum institutional separate account fee charged for this product was 50 bps.

On 23-Aug-2022: the custom benchmark blend was changed from 5% FTSE Canada 91 Day T-Bill, 40% FTSE Canada Universe Bond, 27.5% MSCI AC World and 27.5% S&P/TSX Capped Composite Index to as of 31-Dec-2021: 5% FTSE EPRA/NAREIT Developed Total Return, 42% MSCI World Index -Net Return, 12% S&P/TSX Capped Composite Index and 41% FTSE Canada Universe Bond. The change is retroactive from inception of the composite. The composite asset minimum changed from 5MM USD to 1MM USD effective 1-Nov-2022.
