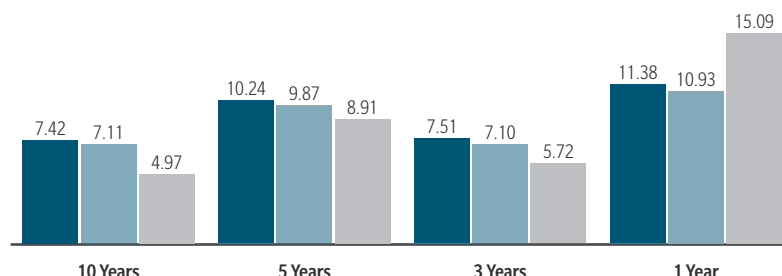
Philosophy

Composite Description: The MFS European Equity ex-U.K. Composite includes all discretionary portfolios managed to the MFS European Equity strategy that restrict investing in securities issued by companies in the United Kingdom. The strategy seeks capital appreciation by investing primarily in a portfolio of European equity securities, excluding the United Kingdom, that MFS believes have attractive valuations and above-average growth prospects. Because the portfolio may invest a substantial amount of its assets in issuers located in a single country or in a limited number of countries, it may be more volatile than a portfolio that is more geographically diversified. Stock markets and investments in individual stocks are volatile and can decline significantly in response to or investor perception of, issuer, market, economic, industry, political, regulatory, geopolitical, and other conditions.

Accounts are eligible for inclusion in the composite if they have assets greater than 1 MM USD. Accounts are included as of their first full month of performance.

Derivative Exposure Disclosure

Certain accounts in this composite utilize derivatives for hedging, investment exposure, implementation efficiency, and transaction cost mitigation purposes. Derivative exposures can be volatile, used to take long or short positions, involve leverage (which can magnify gains or losses), and involve counterparty and liquidity risk. The table below displays the high, median, and low month-end derivative exposures over the last three years, when available or since inception if the composite is less than three years old. Derivative exposure of the account is calculated as the gross equivalent exposure of total net assets. The derivative exposures, displayed below, are the average exposures of the accounts that held derivatives.

Composite Dispersion is measured by the asset-weighted standard deviation of gross of fees account returns for all accounts in the composite for the full period. For composites containing less than six accounts for the full period, dispersion is deemed not meaningful and is not presented. The three-year annualized ex post standard deviation measures the variability of the gross of fees composite returns and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period.

The MFS European Equity ex U.K. composite is a British Pound based composite available globally. The regional composite depicted here was created on 29-Jun-2011 for presentation in the US market. Where appropriate, data has been converted to US Dollar and the fees and breakpoints depicted are applicable to clients in this market.
