Composite Dispersion is measured by the asset-weighted standard deviation of gross of fees account returns for all accounts in the composite for the full period. For composites containing less than six accounts for the full period, dispersion is deemed not meaningful and is not presented. The three-year annualized ex post standard deviation measures the variability of the gross of fees composite returns and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period.

The MFS Global Growth Equity composite is a US Dollar based composite available globally. The regional composite depicted here was created on 24-Oct-2007 for presentation in the Australian market. Where appropriate, data has been converted to Australian Dollar and the fees and breakpoints depicted are applicable to clients in this market.

From 1-Mar-2012 through 30-Jun-2020, the maximum institutional separate account fee charged for this product was 75 bps.
