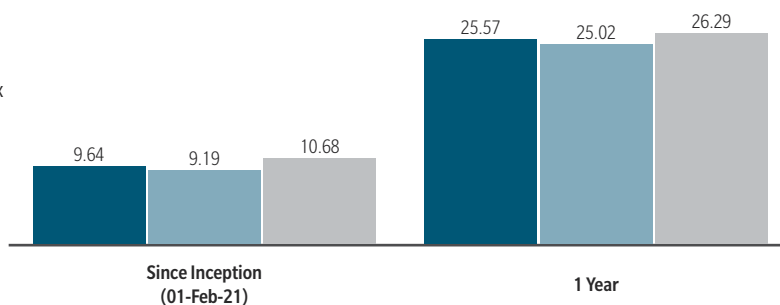
## Philosophy

The three-year annualized ex post standard deviation measures the variability of the gross-of-fees composite returns and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period. Historical performance results may have differed had the composite included assets of client accounts during these time periods for various reasons including the impact of cash flows.

S&P 500 - Total Return - a market capitalization-weighted index of 500 widely held equity securities, designed to measure broad U.S. equity performance.

The composite asset minimum changed from 2MM USD to 1MM USD on 01-Nov-2022.
