The strategy seeks to provide long-term growth of capital through investment in a broadly diversified portfolio of primarily large-capitalization U.S. stocks driven by active stock selection that represents the highest conviction ideas of the MFS Equity Research Analysts. The strategy uses bottom-up analysis to identify high quality (resilient franchises, durable earnings and/or free cash flow growth, strong balance sheet, and strong management team) companies with above average, durable earnings growth potential and is managed generally as sector neutral relative to S&P 500 Index. S&P 500 - Total Return - a market capitalization-weighted index of 500 widely held equity securities, designed to measure broad U.S. equity performance.

Composite Dispersion is measured by the asset-weighted standard deviation of gross of fees account returns for all accounts in the composite for the full period. For composites containing less than six accounts for the full period, dispersion is deemed not meaningful and is not presented. The three-year annualized ex post standard deviation measures the variability of the gross of fees composite returns and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period.

The composite asset minimum changed from 2MM USD to 1MM USD effective 1-Nov-2022.

For purposes of GIPS compliance, the firm is defined as MFS Investment Management (MFS), which is comprised of Massachusetts Financial Services Company and MFS Institutional Advisors, Inc.
