

The strategy focuses on high quality compounders, secular change, sentiment and valuation and takes a long-term view on U.K. stocks seeking to create a high conviction portfolio. FTSE All-Share Capped 5% (TR) - a market capitalization-weighted index that measures the performance of the U.K. stock market, with exposure to any single issuer capped at 5% of the index.

Composite Dispersion is measured by the asset-weighted standard deviation of gross of fees account returns for all accounts in the composite for the full period. For composites containing less than six accounts for the full period, dispersion is deemed not meaningful and is not presented. The three-year annualized ex post standard deviation measures the variability of the gross of fees composite returns and the benchmark returns over the preceding 36-month period.

The composite asset minimum changed from 2MM USD to 1MM USD effective 1-Nov-2022.

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
